CHAPTER 252 FORMERLY SENATE BILL NO. 223

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO DISQUALIFICATION FROM DRIVING A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

Section 1. Amend § 2603, Title 21 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions as shown by underline as follows:

§ 2603. Definitions.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the following definitions apply to this chapter:

() "Human trafficking" means as "human trafficking" is defined in § 787 of Title 11.

Section 2. Amend § 2612, Title 21 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions as shown by underline as follows:

§ 2612. Disqualification and cancellation.

(d) A person is disqualified from driving a commercial motor vehicle for life who uses a motor vehicle in <u>as</u> follows:

(1) In the commission of any felony involving the manufacture, distribution, or dispensing of a controlled substance or possession with intent to manufacture, distribute distribute, or dispense a controlled substance.

(2) In the commission of a felony involving human trafficking.
