AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

Amend Section 4105, Title 15 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions as shown by underline as follows:

- § 4105. Composition of election districts.
- (a) The Department shall create election districts consisting of a minimum of 500 registered voters and a maximum of 3000 registered voters, except where such composition would cause a conflict with representative, senatorial or councilmemberic boundary lines.
 - (b) Allowance for individual exceptions may be made by the State Election Commissioner.
- (c) The Department shall designate all election districts before March 1 in any election year, except in election year 2022, wherein the Department shall designate all election districts before April 1, 2022.
