<b><u>Recommendation &amp; Status</u></b>	<b><u>What to Do Next</u></b>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Recommendation 1:</b></p> <p>Option 1: The Committee will sponsor a bill drafted by the Committee's Legislative Attorney to amend 7 Del. C. § 9113(d) to clarify that the HSCA Fund's 15% cap on administrative costs expenditures is based on the amount deposited into the Fund on a cumulative basis, as follows (including 2 changes to conform existing law with the standards of the Delaware Legislative Drafting Manual):</p> <p>(d) No greater than 15 <del>percent</del> % of the moneys deposited into the Fund <u>on a cumulative basis over the life of the Fund</u> <del>shall</del> <u>may</u> be used for administering this chapter without approval of the Joint Finance Committee.</p> <p>Option 2: The Committee will sponsor a bill drafted by the Committee's Legislative Attorney to amend 7 Del.
