JLOSC has specific <u>rules</u> on public comments accepted at a presentation meeting.

- Comments are limited to the subject at hand (which is the council, commission, or committee under review).
 - Each Staff Report outlines the scope of review.
- Any group, through its spokesperson, is limited to 3 minutes.
- Any Delaware citizen is limited to 2 minutes.
- Zoom meeting registration is required to provide a comment during the presentation meeting.
 - See the meeting announcement and agenda for the meeting's registration link.
 - You must indicate on the registration form which review you will be providing public comment on.
