HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 60

URGING THE SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL TO SUPPORT THE REZONING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY IN  
SUSSEX COUNTY.

1           WHEREAS, "Pick Sweet Foods" is a agricultural commercial entity seeking the rezoning of certain property in  
2 Sussex County Delaware for the purposes of expanding its facilities in the State; and

3           WHEREAS, it is the intent of the General Assembly in adopting this Concurrent Resolution to encourage the  
4 growth in employment and the State's economy which may be brought about by such expansion;

5           NOW THEREFORE:

6           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 141<sup>st</sup> General Assembly of the State of Delaware, the  
7 Senate thereof concurring therein, that the Sussex County Council is hereby encouraged and urged to approve an  
8 application heretofore submitted by Pick Sweet Foods to rezone some 80 acres in Sussex County to the L-I-2 zoning  
9 classification (Light Industrial 2) facilitating the company's expansion in the State.
