SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 1

TO

SENATE BILL NO. 351

1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 351 on page 2 by striking line 19 in its entirety and by substituting the words “protect and  
2 enhance water quality and the health, abundance, and diversity of aquatic life.” in lieu thereof.

3 FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill 351 on page 2 by striking lines 24 and 25 in their entirety and by substituting the  
4 following in lieu thereof: “(4) All relevant public agencies shall recognize the importance of the following coastal and ocean  
5 resource uses: non-consumptive, aesthetic, educational, fishing, scientific, recreational and commercial.”

6 FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill 351 on page 2 by striking line 41 in its entirety and by substituting in lieu thereof the  
7 words “management areas in furthering the goal of healthy ecosystems.”.

8 FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill 351 on page 2 by striking line 43 in its entirety and by substituting in lieu thereof the  
9 words “best available scientific information, effective monitoring, periodic published reviews and the re-evaluation of the need  
10 for the conservation measures.”.

11 FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill 351 on page 4, line 84 by adding the words “and why” immediately following the  
12 word “exist” and before the semicolon (;).

13 FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill 351 on page 4, line 91 by adding the word “conserving,” immediately following the  
14 word “of” and before the word “protecting”.
