<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	<b>AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 29 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTING.</b>

**Assumptions:**

1. This Act becomes effective upon the signature of the Governor.
2. This Act requires that contractors and subcontractors, bidding on State capital projects that meet certain provisions, provide craft training for journeyman and apprentice levels through an approved State or U.S. Department of Labor program.
3. This Act requires the Delaware Department of Labor promulgate the regulations of this Act.
4. The fiscal analysis assumes the need for one casual/seasonal position within the Office of Management and Budget, Government Support Services, at a rate of \$13/hour, working 30 hours per week, for 42 weeks at a total salary and benefit cost of \$17,907. The position will assist in verifying out-of-state and federally certified apprenticeship programs for applicable statewide construction projects.
5. Any costs associated with technology used to support the administration of the provision of this Act are assumed the responsibility of the Agency(s).

\*This Fiscal Note revises its original version, which included the cost of a casual/seasonal position within the Department of Transportation. The Department currently has sufficient staffing to meet the requirements of this Act.
