<b>SPONSOR:</b>	<b>Senator Walsh</b>
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	<b>AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 19 AND TITLE 29 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION.</b>

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**Assumptions:**

1. This Act become effective upon signing by the Governor and takes effect one-year from the date of enactment.
2. This Act revises the Workplace Fraud Act and creates the Delaware Contractor Registration Act, including a contractor registration system to assist in regulating and monitoring employee work classifications.
3. The Department of Labor's Division of Industrial Affairs anticipates the need for new information technology systems to register, monitor, and provide certifications for State contractors as part of the Contractor Registration Act.
4. The Division estimates a one-time cost for the new system to range from \$300,000 to \$315,000. Ongoing administrative costs will be supported by revenue from the annual certificate of registration fee paid by businesses that engage in construction activities in the State.
5. The Department of Labor's Appropriated Special Fund appropriation includes resources for the purchase of the new contractor registration system.
