DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 14 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO FULL-

DAY KINDERGARTEN.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Fiscally effective July 1, 2008.

- 2. This Act requires school districts, by the start of the 2008-2009 school year, to offer any kindergarten-eligible child the option of attending full-day kindergarten if the child's parent or guardian so chooses.
- 3. Based on current kindergarten enrollments, an estimated 370 units would be generated with unit costs as follows (includes other employment costs):

- 4. Based on current capacity within the local school districts, an estimated 131 additional classrooms would be required.
- 5. The cost estimate assumes 100% of eligible children will attend full day kindergarten.
- 6. Subject to specific appropriation by the General Assembly.
- 7. The Fiscal Year 2006 Bond and Capital Improvements Act includes \$13,000,000 for Full Day Kindergarten Construction Contingency. Additionally, the Governor's Recommended Annual Appropriations Act includes \$6,700,000 for Full Day Kindergarten operating costs.
