HOUSE BILL NO. 515 AS AMENDED BY HOUSE AMENDMENT NO. 1

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO TINTED WINDOWS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

Section 1. Amend §4313 of Title 21 of the Delaware Code by inserting a new subsection "(f)" to read as follows:

"(f) This section shall not apply to any surveillance vehicles operated by a police officer, as defined under §8401(5) of Title 11 of this Code. This exception shall not apply to marked vehicles, or those unmarked vehicles used primarily for regular duty patrols."

Section 2. The Division of Motor Vehicles and any agency owning vehicles the agency wishes to qualify under this exception to the tinting requirements of the Code shall coordinate to create an effective method to identify those surveillance vehicles and avoid confusion during the safety inspection process.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect immediately upon signing by the Governor.
