## DELAWARE STATE SENATE 145th GENERAL ASSEMBLY

## SENATE BILL NO. 198

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Amend § 4339(a) of Title 21 of the Delaware Code by deleting that subsection in its entirety and

2 replacing it with the following:

- 3 "(a) Front clearance lamps and those marker lamps and reflectors mounted on the front or on the side near the
- 4 front of a vehicle shall display and reflect an amber color."
- 5 Section 2. Amend § 4339(b) of Title 21 of the Delaware Code by deleting the subsection in its entirety and
- 6 replacing it with the following:
- 7 "(b) Rear clearance lamps and those marker lamps and reflectors mounted on the rear or on the sides near the rear
- 8 of a vehicle shall display and reflect a red color."

## SYNOPSIS

This Bill brings Delaware into compliance with the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS) which requires the front marker lights and the front reflectors of a vehicle to be amber, and the rear marker lights and the rear reflectors of a vehicle to be red.
