

153rd GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: SENATE BILL NO. 26

SPONSOR: Senator Brown

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 19 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO

UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION.

Assumptions:

1. This Act becomes effective upon signature by the Governor.

- 2. This Act changes the law allowing workers subject to a labor dispute other than a lockout to collect unemployment benefits after a 2-week waiting period if they meet all eligibility requirements.
- 3. The Department of Labor anticipates the need for one-time system technology upgrades to implement the provisions of this Act.
- 4. The Department of Labor, Division of Unemployment Insurance, believes it can absorb the cost within its current Appropriated Special Funds (ASF) collected from unemployment insurance taxes.
